## LinkedIn Level 3 - Maximizing your LinkedIn Usage Student/Scholar Learning Outcomes (SLOs) and Tasks to Earn a Digital Badge

## **Badge Description**

Recipients of the LinkedIn 301 badges have completed work both on their own and in cooperation with a School team member to refine how they use LinkedIn to meet the expectations and norms of a target career path. This includes receiving feedback from individuals in a job/role similar to their target path. Additionally, recipients will show mastery of the aspects of LinkedIn an individual in the biomedical sciences would need to successfully find a job using this tool.

## Required tasks for this microcredential will be

- 1. Have already earned the LinkedIn Level 1 digital badge and the LinkedIn Level 2 digital badge.
- 2. Submit updated profile for review; must have made modifications based on previous review, and extend the profile based on Level 1 and Level 2 sessions
- 3. Submit an updated plan for LinkedIn usage in the following areas: connection strategy; affiliation strategy (mentions, groups, likes); marketing strategy. Include metrics for monitoring the plan, and provide updates on how well you have met these metrics
- 4. Submit two reviews of your profile by individuals who work in roles related to your desired career path (or are recruiters/HR specialists for those career paths)
- 5. Meet with a representative of the Graduate Division related to your LinkedIn Leve 3 training plan to review and discuss your progress towards this digital badge
